## THE WOLVERINE ROOT CANAL & CROWN PROGRAM

*(a.k.a. "Wolverine Endo-Crown")*

### WHAT:

A special program of dental services from the University of Michigan School of Dentistry, especially for military veterans who are in need of a root canal and crown restoration on a molar tooth. This would be determined through a dental office visit that would include an exam by a dentist and x-rays.

### WHERE:

The dental services will be provided at the University of Michigan School of Dentistry Graduate Endodontics and Graduate Restorative Dentistry clinics, 1011 N. University, Ann Arbor, MI 48109.

### COST:

The dental services will be provided **FREE** of charge for any U.S. military veterans that are determined to need a root canal and crown restoration on a molar tooth. Proof of veteran status is required with either a Veteran's ID Card or copy of DD214.
